

1 MR. ROYCE: Hey, Brian. What's happening, man?

2 MR. GREENWELL: What's happening, man?

3 MR. ROYCE: My name is Detective Royce. Detective
4 Hogan. And sorry it took me a little while to get over here.
5 I was finishing up talking to Jody.

6 MR. GREENWELL: Jody?

7 MR. ROYCE: Mm-hmm.

8 MR. GREENWELL: How's she doing?

9 MR. ROYCE: She's a little upset.

10 MR. GREENWELL: About what?

11 MR. ROYCE: Well, that's what we're to talk about.
12 She's a little upset. I will tell you that she -- I'm trying
13 to remember her exact words, but it was more along the lines
14 of, "I don't want it -- tell him I don't want him to be scared
15 and" -- and to talk to us. Anything else on -- along that
16 'cause I wanted -- "I want to go talk to him." I said, "I
17 can't let you do that." I said, "I may be able to let you do a
18 recorded statement or write a note, but..."

19 MR. GREENWELL: So she do one of them?

20 MR. ROYCE: I have a recording. I also have another
21 recording that I'd like you to view as well. But I -- I can't
22 ask you any questions yet, because you're in custody for
23 something else. I don't know -- I know it's some kind of dope
24 charge. I know you had some stuff there. So before I actually

1 ask you anything or tell you or show you anything, I need to
2 read you your rights. You had those read before, correct?

3 MR. GREENWELL: No.

4 MR. ROYCE: You've never had your rights read?

5 MR. GREENWELL: No.

6 MR. ROYCE: Okay. Let's go through that.

7 MR. GREENWELL: I mean, when I was younger, yeah.

8 MR. ROYCE: Right, but --

9 MR. GREENWELL: But as far as getting them again --

10 MR. ROYCE: But you know what I'm talking about?

11 MR. GREENWELL: Yeah, I know what you're talking
12 about.

13 MR. ROYCE: Well, I'm going to go through this
14 because, like I said -- and I brought a picture of your kiddos.

15 MR. GREENWELL: Oh, man. Really?

16 MR. ROYCE: I get -- and I gave her -- I gave her a
17 picture of them too.

18 All right. Before we ask you any questions, you must
19 understand your rights. You got the right to remain silent.
20 Anything you say can and will be used against you in a court of
21 law. Right to talk to a lawyer prior to any question or making
22 any statements, have him present with you while you're being
23 questioned. Can't afford to hire a lawyer, one will be
24 appointed by the court to represent you before any questioning,
25 if you desire one.

1 You may stop the questioning or make any statements
2 at any time by refusing to answer further or requesting to
3 consult with an attorney prior to continuing with questioning
4 or making any statements. And those are your rights.

5 And the second part of this -- this form is just --
6 it's a waiver of your rights, and it basically says,
7 I'm -- "I've read this statement on my rights or I've had them
8 read to me, and I understand what my rights are; and I'm
9 willing to make a statement and answer some questions. I don't
10 want a lawyer at this time, and I understand and know what I'm
11 doing. No promises or threats have been made to me, and no
12 pressure and coercion of any kind has been used against me."
13 You understand what coercion means, right?

14 MR. GREENWELL: Mm-hmm.

15 MR. ROYCE: Okay. And I'm guessing you might have an
16 idea of what -- you don't have an idea of what -- what you
17 might want to talk to me about or what I want to talk to you
18 about? Okay. And -- and it has to do with the apartment you
19 guys used to live in over on Shelby Street.

20 MR. GREENWELL: Oh. Well, yeah. I mean --

21 MR. ROYCE: I mean, does that ring a bell --

22 MR. GREENWELL: Yeah.

23 MR. ROYCE: -- and that incident? Okay. What do you
24 know about that incident?

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1 MR. GREENWELL: Far as I know, they was -- that was
2 supposed to have been us, far as my understanding.

3 MR. ROYCE: Mm-hmm.

4 MR. GREENWELL: 'Cause the guy, Terry Payne,
5 that -- he was supposed to have sent somebody over to talk to
6 us or something like that, but I don't know 'cause they used to
7 have deals -- well, I mean, I know the guy too, you know. They
8 used to have dealings or some -- something like that, and I'm
9 not even sure if it's him. You know what I'm saying? I'm just
10 going by what I've heard, that -- he got ripped off for some
11 dope a few times.

12 He got upset about it. And the only reason why he
13 wouldn't come confront her by herself, you know what I'm
14 saying, 'cause of me, which she ain't never ripped him off for
15 no dope anyways. It wasn't her. You know, it was --

16 MR. ROYCE: So this was -- it was geared towards Jody
17 is what you're telling me?

18 MR. GREENWELL: Yes. And far as I know that somebody
19 was supposed to have sent some people from Chicago, some black
20 dudes. He said, "It's not about the money now. It's not about
21 the dope. It's about the principle." And he, Terry Payne,
22 told me this. And I told him, I said, "Well, you better go
23 back and tell him you're right. It's not about no money. It's
24 not about no principle; but it seems like someone's fucking
25 around with my -- my fiancé. Then it pulls me. You know what

1 I'm saying? I'm involved." And he said, "Well, it's already
2 too late. The -- the calls have been made and that some people
3 from" -- what'd he say -- New Orleans or something like that.
4 Fucking Louisiana's up here looking for her. And that's when I
5 noticed that -- started being followed. And I'm like, hold up.
6 You know, maybe this shit's true.

7 'Cause I've been thinking it's all, you know -- you
8 know how people get talking just to try to scare somebody. And
9 I kept noticing people following me and I kept noticing people
10 following me; and I'm like, hold the fuck up, hold it, you
11 know. So I made a phone call, and I was like, "Dude, what the
12 fuck is going on?" He said, "Man, I" -- he said, "I told you."
13 He said, "I'll try to go talk to them." I said, "Dude, you
14 better do more than try to go talk to them."

15 And for the past, I don't know, month and a half,
16 something like that, every time I walked out the door, I was
17 being followed. And for the life of me, nobody believed me. I
18 mean, I told everybody. I said, "Man, somebody is following
19 us. Somebody's following me or somebody's following you,
20 somebody." And then I got locked up.

21 MR. ROYCE: What happened with that whole little --

22 MR. GREENWELL: That --

23 MR. ROYCE: I'm not the dope police

24 or -- you know, I just --

25 MR. GREENWELL: I mean, I -- I --

1 MR. ROYCE: I'm trying to get to the south end, a
2 little tour and --

3 MR. GREENWELL: Hell, I heard she burned, but -- I
4 mean, not one time did nobody ever say, "Police." Nobody
5 said -- I went the whole time, thinking -- I told everybody I
6 was being followed. I mean, I've had people run up on me, and
7 I'm like -- I'd take off. Nobody ever said, "Cops," you know?
8 So I don't know if it's the cops or if it's them or whoever,
9 whatever. You know what I'm saying? I'm like, shit. So I
10 done what I do -- know to do best, protect myself and get the
11 hell out of that situation for a moment.

12 But that situation, it was same thing. Few cars
13 whipped up on me. Then once I took off, yeah, he hit his
14 lights. I'm like, you know -- I got a set of them lights,
15 which I do. You know what I'm saying? I got a flashlight that
16 turns -- you know what I'm saying? You click it one time, it
17 sits there and flashes red, white, -- I mean, red, blue and --
18 them lights. You know what I'm saying?

19 I'm like, so nobody's ever said, "Stop. Police.
20 It's the Louisville -- this is the feds, this is the whoever."
21 You know what I'm saying? So I'm -- I didn't stop, you know?
22 Even when we got back to the house we were staying at, not one
23 time did anybody say, "Police. This is the police. This is
24 the whoever, blah, blah." They just told me, get the fuck down
25 or they're gonna blow my goddamn brains out.

1 I'm like, well, there's a chance I got to take.
2 Either they're the police -- and then once they all started
3 coming up on me, I noticed it was the police 'cause I seen them
4 with all the equipment and shit like that, you know. And I was
5 like, well, maybe this is the cops, so I got down.

6 MR. ROYCE: Who all -- who all did you get arrested
7 with that night?

8 MR. GREENWELL: Me, Jody, Lala, and Chris.

9 MR. ROYCE: Does Lala have a real name? Everybody
10 keeps saying Lala; and I'm like, I don't know who she is. And
11 it -- as I say, I'm not the dope police; but I'm just curious
12 for my own --

13 MR. GREENWELL: It's Lauren. I know it's Lauren. I
14 don't know her last name.

15 MR. ROYCE: And it really doesn't matter for me. I'm
16 just curious.

17 MR. GREENWELL: Yeah.

18 MR. ROYCE: 'Cause everybody says Lala, and I'm like,
19 okay. Last somebody named Lala, it was on -- on a kids' TV
20 show, but -- all right. Let me take you back to that -- that
21 apartment on Shelby. How -- how long had y'all stayed there?

22 MR. GREENWELL: Man, I think --

23 MR. ROYCE: I mean, is it --

24 MR. GREENWELL: -- I'd just got out of jail, and I
25 don't know if she's had it before I went in --

1 MR. ROYCE: All right.

2 MR. GREENWELL: -- or before -- right before I got
3 out or what. I think it was only -- I was only there, like,
4 couple weeks maybe.

5 MR. ROYCE: Got you.

6 MR. GREENWELL: Something like that. Maybe a little
7 longer. I know it's, like, between two -- two weeks -- two to
8 three weeks.

9 MR. ROYCE: Okay.

10 MR. GREENWELL: Something like that.

11 MR. ROYCE: And you guys never went back to that
12 apartment?

13 MR. GREENWELL: Yeah, we went back.

14 MR. ROYCE: You did?

15 MR. GREENWELL: Yeah. We went back and got some of
16 our stuff.

17 MR. ROYCE: Okay.

18 MR. GREENWELL: I mean, we'd seen the landlord;
19 nothing was ever said. We seen cops sitting there; nothing was
20 ever said to us. I was like, well, this ain't got nothing to
21 do with us, I hope.

22 MR. ROYCE: Did you know those neighbors? Had y'all
23 talked to them?

24 MR. GREENWELL: No.

25 MR. ROYCE: Y'all never -- you never saw them before?

1 MR. GREENWELL: I mean, yeah, we seen them in
2 passing, but --

3 MR. ROYCE: If I showed you a picture of them, would
4 you know who they are?

5 MR. GREENWELL: I'm pretty sure I would be.

6 MR. ROYCE: All right.

7 MR. GREENWELL: Yeah. I think -- yeah, that was her.

8 MR. ROYCE: Okay.

9 MR. GREENWELL: Now, the guy --

10 MR. ROYCE: Now, this is a little bit of an older
11 picture. I think he had probably just gotten out of jail, and
12 his hair may have been a lot longer.

13 MR. GREENWELL: Yeah. If you put long hair on him --

14 MR. ROYCE: Okay.

15 MR. GREENWELL: -- looks like him.

16 MR. ROYCE: And y'all didn't have any interaction
17 with them?

18 MR. GREENWELL: No. Other than, I mean, passing them
19 through the hallways or -- but it was just -- I think it was,
20 what, one, two -- two -- two apartments --

21 MR. ROYCE: Yeah, it's just two.

22 MR. GREENWELL: Two, yeah.
